### Vicar Message

Ettu Nombu is the commemoration of the Nativity of Mother Mary. The commemoration of the Nativity of St. Mary on 8thSeptember is the result of the Immaculate Conception theory of the

blessed virgin by the Roman Catholic Church. Orthodox Churches reject the immaculate conception of St. Mary. That is why our church has not listed it among the canonical feasts. So the observation of Ettu Nombu is discouraged and declared as against the faith and belief of the Church. Immaculate Conception means mother Mary born without the effect of the Adam's sin and was holy pure. This may lead to biblical heresy (Rom 3:10,20,23-24) and contrary to the effect of Adamic sin. If Mariam was devoid of the effect of the Adam sin then Christ cannot be considered as the savior of the entire creation. Our belief is that Mariam was also a part and parcel to the Christ's salvific act. Then the question arise, "how the savior born in the womb of a sinner?" Mary by virtue of her righteousness, faith and willingness to accede to the will of God, cleansed and illuminated by grace from the inheritance of flawed nature from Adam and made perfect when conceived Theotokosin her womb. When we say she was without any sin from the birth then we may force to equate her with Christ or delimit Christ to mere human or perfect human and not 'Son of God'. Then why in our churches the nativity of St. Mary is been celebrated. This is because of the local pietism and not out of real understanding. Local pietism is woven out of prosperity theology. It is popular not because of the spiritual aspect it has but due to the emotional, physical and material benefits it contains. Moreover taking fast and nombu at any time is beneficial for the spiritual strengthening of believers.

The feast of Holy Cross on 14th September is a canonical feast related with the recovery of crucified cross of Christ by gueen Helene of Constantinople. Cross till then a symbol of humiliation, contempt and damnation became a sign of victory, salvation and hope. Orthodox Christians prefer plain Cross instead of Cross with the crucified image of Christ. Plain Cross symbolizes the resurrection of Christ. Symbols and signs are not a later development or perversion of religious practice by the Christians. The earliest symbols used by ancient Christians were:-Chi-Rho. Chi and Rho are the first two letters (XP) of

"Christ" in Greek XPISTOS. (Christos). Fish Symbol . Another







common symbol was the fish. The fish (Greek ichthus). through a Greek acrostic, Iosous Christos, Theou Yios, Sōtēr), which translates into English as "Jesus Christ, God's Son, Saviour"

Good Shepherd Symbol Also very popular is the Good Shepherd, a symbol of Christ's care for his sheep (lohn 10:11).

Dove Symbol. Finally, a dove

with an olive branch in its mouth appears as a symbol of the peace and happiness of the soul. Only occasionally in catacomb art does the dove represent as the Holy Spirit. Thus symbols are the tools to communicate the faith and beliefs of a believer. Use of these symbols are not an idol worship as widely accused by the certain Christians. It is an image that express the hidden mystery of an ornate form. Veneration of cross is not an idol worship but an honour ascribed to the great sacrifice of our lord and making it a path to be followed.

September also have a great importance for the entire Malayali community. On this month we celebrate Onam. It is a festival that symbolizes sacrifice, love, prosperity and unity.

All the above mentioned events teach us that life is fast and feast, love and sacrifice and above all supreme images of inspiration and imitation. On the occasion of Ettu Nombu, Sleeba Perunnal and Onam, we express our hearty wishes to all parish members. Yours in Christ
