## Points System - 2012

Our Sunday School uses a Points System to reward the children who excel in Examination, Attendance and various Talent Scan events. Points are awarded based on the results of each of the events as mentioned below and trophies, medals and other prizes are given based on the total points received by a student on the Anniversary day. The following describes the Points System based on which the results of 2012 onwards will be arrived at:

**Examination:** Two unit tests and one oral test for classes 5 and below (excluding Pre-KG) or two units tests and one project for classes 5 and above.

**Class 5 & below:** 1<sup>st</sup> Unit Test – 40 marks, 2<sup>nd</sup> Unit Test – 50 marks and Oral – 10 marks. Total 100 marks for Academic assessment.

Above Class 5: Unit test 1 - 40 marks; Unit test 2 - 50 marks; Project – 10 marks; Total 100 marks for Academic Assessment.

Depending on the marks received by the student, points are awarded as follows (for all class category):

Those who get below 50% are not awarded any points but the students in class 5 and below are given special consolation prizes.

Attendance: Attendance is marked for class attendance as well as attendance in Holy Qurbana in English which are conducted on 2nd Fridays at NECK. Attendance in English Holy Qurbana will be recorded by distributing Coupons to Students after Kaimuthu / Offertory. The filled-in coupons, returned to their class teachers the week after, will be recorded as Attendance in English Holy Qurbana. Total class days vary from 25 through 31 in a year and 9 days of Holy Qurbana in English

To encourage students to participate in the Holy Qurbana in English, additional points will be awarded for attendance in Holy Qurbana in English.

Medical leaves with parent's written request are excluded from the above absence days. In order to get points for attendance, the student must have obtained at least 50% marks in the examinations.

## Talents Scan:

- a. Minimum of 3 contestants (individual or group) are mandatory for any TS event, otherwise, the event will be cancelled.
- b. Minimum 50% of the time limit should be utilised by the contestant to qualify to score marks.

For every event, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> positions will be awarded. Single items and group items have different grading as follows:

Students who receive 70 or more points will be given a Trophy. However students who do not get minimum 50% marks and 50% attendance will not be eligible for trophy. Other prizes are as follows:

- 60 69 points gets a Gold Medal
- 50 59 points gets a Silver Medal
- 40 49 points gets a Bronze Medal

Special prizes are given to those who get below 40 points and those who do not get any points who are in class 5 and below (consolation prizes). Pre-KG students do not have any test or they do not participate in any talent scan events. They are all given special consolation prizes.

## Ever-Rolling Trophy & Headmaster's Trophy:

These prizes will be awarded based on total points received for the Annual Examination, Attendance and Talents Scan events. Highest points in the school get the Headmaster's trophy and the second highest point gets the Trophy sponsored by Late Very Rev. Elias Thomas Cor-Episcopa Educational Society. Highest points in each group (KG, Infants, Sub-Juniors, Juniors, Intermediate and Seniors) get Ever Rolling Trophy sponsored in memory of Late Very Rev. Zachariah Karuvelil Cor-Episcopa in addition to individual trophies and certificates.
