Points System revised as per PTA/Core Committee decision on 25-Aug-19

Our Sunday School uses a Points System to reward the children who excel in Examination, Attendance and various Talent Scan events. Points are awarded based on the results of each of the events as mentioned below and trophies, medals and other prizes are given based on the total points received by a student on the Anniversary day.

The following describes the Points System based on which the results will be arrived at:

Examination: Two written tests and one oral test for classes 5 and below (excluding Pre-KG) and two written tests for classes 6 and above.

Class 3 & below: Half yearly exam (Oral)– 50 marks & Final Exam (Oral) – 50 marks. Total 100 marks for Academic assessment.

Class 4,5 & 6: Half yearly written exam – 40 marks, Final written Exam – 40 marks, Orals (Prayers, Hymns, Psalms, GK from syllabus book) – 10 marks & Project 10 Marks. Total 100 marks for Academic assessment.

Class 7, 8 & 9: Half yearly written exam – 40 marks, Final written Exam – 40 marks, Written (Prayers, Hymns, Psalms, GK from syllabus book) – 10 marks & Project 10 Marks. Total 100 marks for Academic assessment.

Class 11: Half yearly written exam – 50 marks, Final written exam – 50 marks. Total 100 marks for Academic assessment.

Class 10 & 12: Grades of Class 10 and 12 Central Exam are converted to marks and points awarded as given below.

Depending on the marks received by the student, points are awarded as follows (for all class category):

Attendance: Attendance is marked for class attendance as well as any special functions with prior notice. Total class attendance days vary from 25 through 32 in a year.

Class Attendance Points

Full attendance or up to 3 absence	12 points
4 absence	10 points
5 absence	8 points
6 absence	6 points

Medical leaves with parent's written request are excluded from the above absence days. In order to get points for attendance, the student must have obtained at least 35% marks in the examinations.

Talents Scan:

50% attendance in Sunday School classes (1st and 2nd term together) is necessary for awarding any points in Talents Scan.

1st , 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th positions will be awarded for every event with points as given below. A student can participate in 4 single and 1 group event. Single and group events have different points as below:

Students who receive overall (i.e. Examination + Attendance + Talents Scan) 60 or more points will be given a Trophy. However students who do not get minimum 35% marks in Examination and 50% Attendance will not be eligible for trophy. Other prizes are as follows:

50 – 59 points gets a Gold Medal

40 – 49 points gets a Silver Medal

30 – 39 points gets a Bronze Medal

Special prizes are given to those who get below 30 points and those who do not get any points who are in class 5 and below (consolation prizes). Pre-KG students do not have any test or they do not participate in any talent scan events however all the Pre-KG children are given special consolation prizes.

Ever-Rolling Trophy & Headmaster's Trophy:

These prizes will be awarded based on total points received for the Annual Examination, Attendance and Talents Scan events. Highest points in the school get the Headmaster's trophy and the second highest point gets the Trophy sponsored by Late Very Rev. Elias Thomas Cor-Episcopa Educational Society. Highest points in each group (KG, Infants, Sub-Juniors, Juniors, Intermediate and Seniors) get Ever Rolling Trophy sponsored in memory of Late Very Rev. Zachariah Karuvelil Cor-Episcopa in addition to individual trophies and certificates.
