The period from Easter Sunday to Pentecost is known as 'Season of Resurrection'. Seven weeks are there in this season. During Great lent period faithfuls make a remarkable change in their life for repentance by fasting and prostration to achieve purification and deification. But in the Season of Resurrection, Church celebrates the Victory of The Cross over death and sin.



That's why there is no prostration during these fifty days. We find clear description about this in the decision (20th canon) of Nicene Synod (A.D.325).

The Sunday after Easter is known as 'New Sunday'. It denotes the newness in the creation and all human beings by defeating death on the Cross and through resurrection. Deceased creation is renewed and receives the hope of eternal life and becomes a new creation. Every Sunday reminds us about resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. So this great idea led us to make Sunday as "Lord's Day'. New Testament indicates Lord's Day as second coming of Jesus Christ. (ICor5:5, I Thes 5:2, II Pet3; 10).But in the book of Revelation 1:10 the Lord's Day is described as Sunday or First Day of the week. That's why we recite in the "Holy Qurbana", 'We commemorate thy death O Lord and we confess thy resurrection and awaits for thy second coming".

Ascension of Christ reminds us of the departure of His Glorified body to the heaven. It is a sign and symbol of the second coming (Acts1:9-11). The importance of the Feast of Ascension is that Jesus glorified our fallen and sinful humanity when He returned to the Father and brings human nature to the divine Kingdom.

Following His Ascension, Christ the saviour fulfilled His promise and sent the Holy Spirit, the 'comforter' and appeared to the disciples as tongues of fire on the Day of Pentecost. According to the patriarchs of the oriental church, Jesus Christ incarnated in to this world because God wanted the Holy Spirit to dwell in us. Let us renew the Holy Spirit which we received through the sacrament of baptism and sing the hymns of the feast:

'Blessed one You O Christ Our Lord, who made fishermen all-wise by sending down upon them the Holy Spirit and through them drawing the entire world into your net. O loving one, Glory be to You'. Amen
